



BBUFA Crèche Parental Involvement Policy

Parents are the most significant person in a young child's life. Our crèche intends to work with parents, supporting, encouraging and reinforcing best practice and guiding or advising when parents ask for suggestions of ways of caring and coping with children.

In order to do this we:

- Ensure all parents know about our aims and policies including our complaints procedure.
- Provide parents with advice and support in the crèche settling in procedure to enable them to be as fully involved as possible in settling their child into the crèche prior to it commencing.
- Give parents feedback on their child's progress at the end of each session using specific examples of achievement or behaviour including the individual care that has been given to their child.
- Encourage parents to become actively involved in our organisation and actively encourage and support any volunteering or job opportunities within it.
- Listen to parents' comments and opinions about the crèche and use these to shape our future practices.
- Ensure parents know the time and venue of the crèche.
- Inform parents about training, and events which may interest them.
- Ensure copies of any inspection reports are available for parents.
